Oasis Resources is the place to purchase weekly messages on CD. Specialty books and resources are also available for purchase.

Nursery & Preschool are provided. Parents with infants and preschool children are encouraged to take advantage of our excellent nursery and preschool classes which provide a warm, nurturing and well-supervised program. Your child will be much happier with our trained volunteers than in the worship service. Our KIDZ Corner volunteers will direct you to the proper classroom. A *silent paging system* is provided in our Auditorium to notify you in the event you are needed. The display will appear in the bottom right corner of the video screen. **If you decide to keep your child with you during the worship service, please be considerate of those seated around you.** A speaker is located in the Lobby which will allow you to hear the worship music and message if you need to leave the Auditorium.

Cell Phones. Thank you for helping us cut down on distractions by turning off your cell phones, pagers, and watches.

Communion Service. We share communion each Sunday at Community. The unleavened bread reminds us of Jesus' body and the cup of juice reminds us of Jesus' blood. If you are a believer, you are invited to join us. Please eat and drink after prayerful meditation, placing your empty cup in the holder located on the back of the seats in front of you.

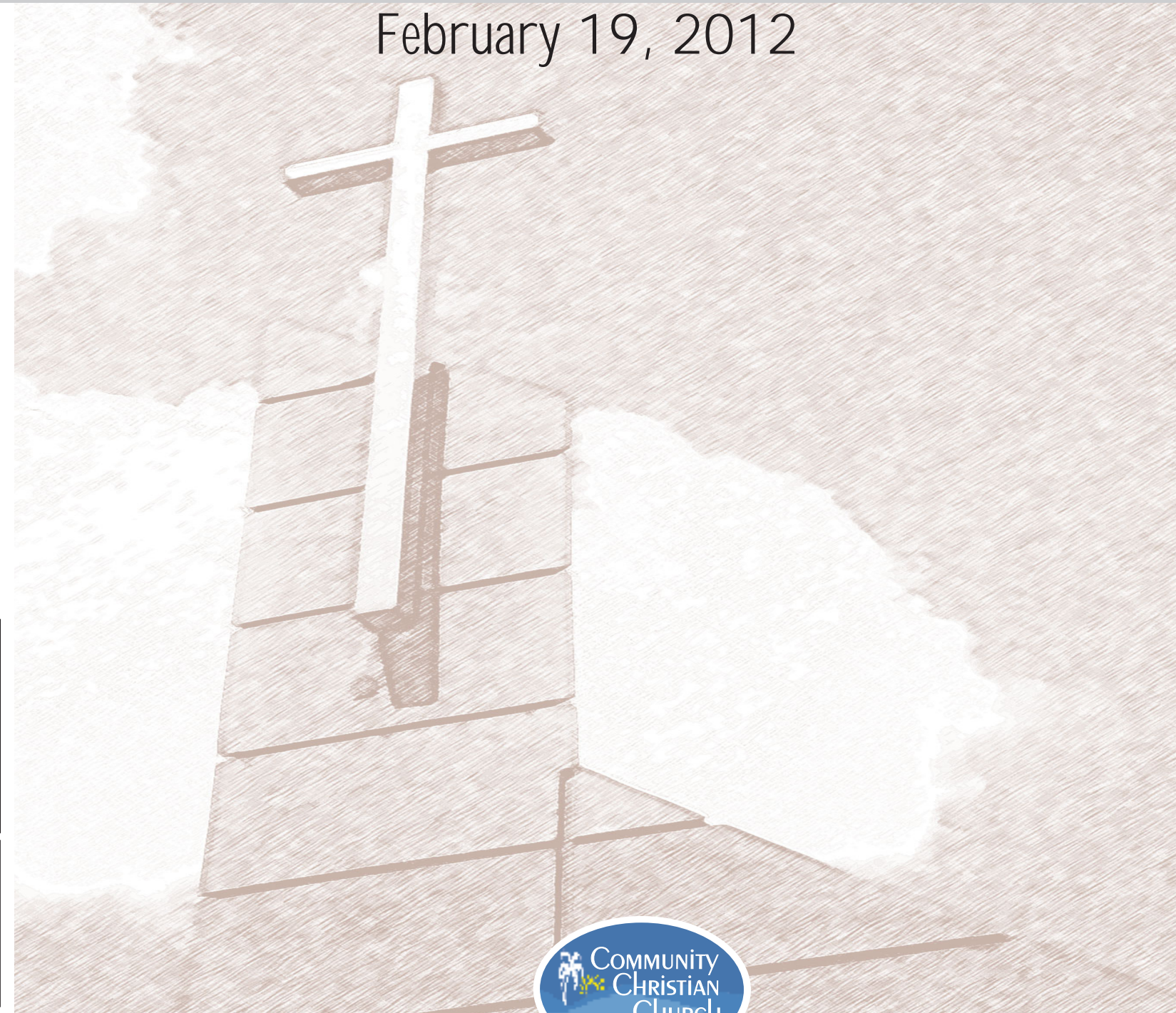
